Matriculation of newly admitted students

19. 9. 2019

Matriculation refers exclusively to newly admitted students to the first bachelor's and postgraduate master's degree programs in the **full-attendance form**, who study for the first time at the faculty. Newly admitted students in the **par-time form** of bachelor's and follow-up master's study programs who are studying for the first time at the faculty will take the matriculation letter to the Study department by **10th November 2019** at the latest and confirm by signing the matriculation pledge.
